Easter Publicity

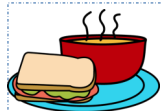

Sunday 12th April 2026

The church's Electoral Roll is the register of it's voting members; it is a list of those qualified to attend and to vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting, which this year is on Sunday 10th May. Electoral Rolls provide an indication of the real membership and strength of the Church.

Who can be on the Electoral Roll? Baptised adults over 16 years who live in the parish, or who have worshipped regularly at St George's for at least 6 months (*unless prevented from doing so by illness*) and are committed to being part of the life of the local Church of England congregation.

Why join? Enrolment is a way of saying.... "I belong". It is an act of commitment to St. George's Church and the Church as a whole. It opens the way for involvement in the life of the Church at parish, deanery, diocesan and national level.

So, if you've started attending St George's in the last 12 months and comply with the other criteria, please complete an Electoral Roll Application form, available as you come into the church or by contacting the Church Office.

To check that your details are correct on the Roll please contact the Church Office. **If you need to make any amendments** (*to change your name or address, for instance*) please complete a new form.

We take your privacy very seriously at St George's. Details of how we will use the information you supply are on the Electoral Roll Privacy Notice at the back of the church.

If you have any questions about anything to do with the Electoral Roll please contact Helen in the Church Office, or speak to John.
